<u>Photography</u>: Photography entries are due to Beth by March 24, 2016. Please e-mail them to <u>e-whitener@tamu.edu</u>.

Photographs should be taken at the highest resolution possible. Photographs must be in a .jpeg,.jpg or.gif formation. All photos must be 8x10 in size. Photos should be at least 800 pixels by 1000 pixels. The ideal 8x10 quality is 2400pixels by 3000 pixels, which is the same as an 8x10 photo at 300 dpi(resolution). Higher variations of the 8x10 ratio are allowed but the final size may not be larger than 2,048k (2MB).
